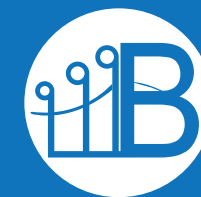

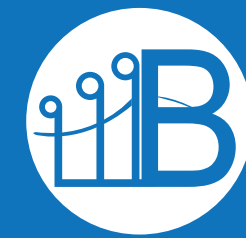

What we want



Youth City Berlin (charity)

We plan four different areas.

It is proposed that 25 ha (62 acres) of Tempelhof Field should be set aside for the International Youth City, planned and executed for and by young and old people working side by side.

1. Living quarters for young people, „**Youth living Town**“
The rent per month should not exceed € 100.- The tenant is requested to work 6 hours per week for the project.

2. „**Topics Town**“: Houses dedicated to certain fields. They would represent as many areas as possible from industry, trade, crafts, sports, art, music, politics etc. We challenge organisations and firms to participate.

3. A „**Children Town**“, modelled after the SOS Children Village.

4. A „**Senior Town**“ for older people, who still want to give and learn.

The property remains in the hands of the City of Berlin, to be used solely for this experiment.

We want to enable young people in distress to participate in social life. We believe this is a prerequisite for a peaceful coexistence.

Parents sometimes are unable to help their children and to provide stimulation for their talents and interests. In order to help effectively, we wish to start with the very young ones .

The City of Berlin has to hand over to Social Services roughly 3000 children per year.

Young-at-heart senior citizens enjoy more and more passing on what they can do and know well. Affordable housing is lacking for that age-group, too.

We all live in one world and are responsible for one another. We all benefit by taking care of our environment , a task we have to work on together.

We want to offer the possibility for people with the same interests to meet and to do things together. Young and old, poor and rich can get to know and help one another.

Berlin visitors can participate, too.

Children, young people and families can find their way into a fulfilling life together more easily.

Doing things together is a great way for integrating into each other's culture.

A peaceful coexistence can be learned with the method of „Nonviolent Communication“ (NVC).

The buildings will be erected by young people under supervision in the „cradle – to - cradle“ method.

It is increasingly difficult to find affordable housing in Berlin.

Therefore it helps families , when older teenagers don't have to live at home any more.

The project, once erected, will carry itself by the rent and the work of the tenants.
